Everyone's life had been topsy-turvy in the past two years. While social interaction dwindled, dependence on mechanical gizmos and gadgets increased.



Students from 10 local schools of Visakhapatnam, participated in the competition which was conducted online on 3-9-22 via Microsoft Teams .

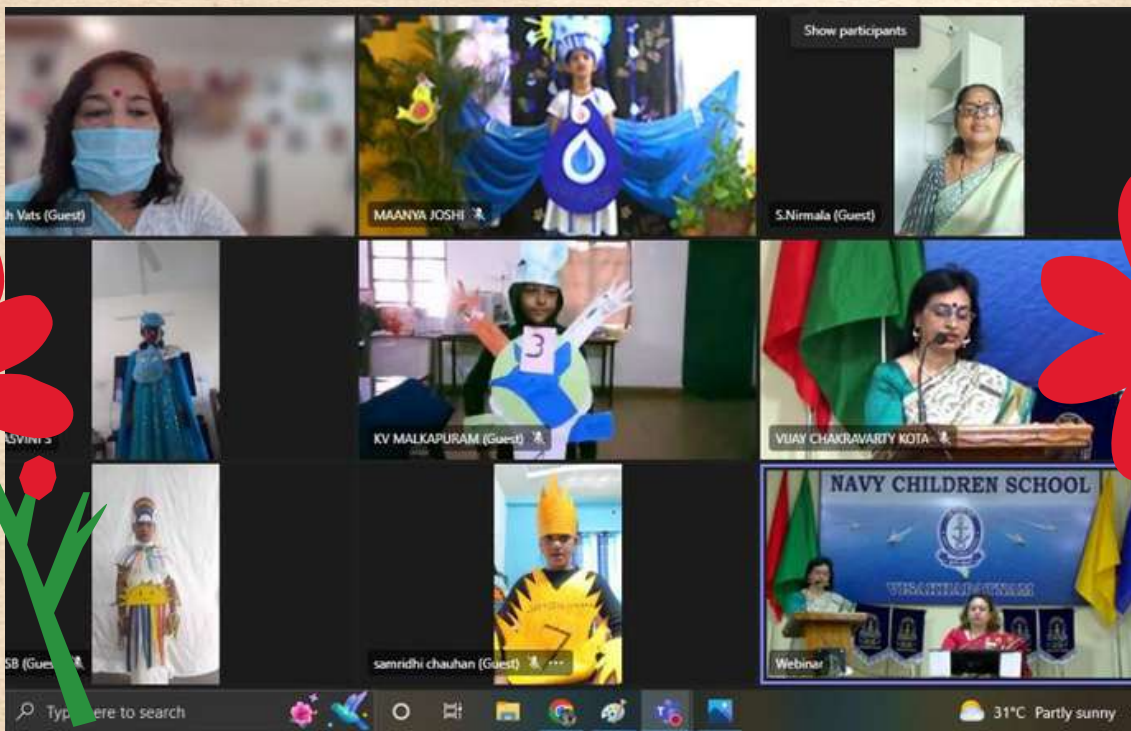
Dr Parul Kumar , Principal, NCS, Visakhapatnam, declared the results in the result declaration ceremony that was conducted after the event.

E-vouchers and e-certificates have been sent to the winners . All the participants received the participation e- certificates.



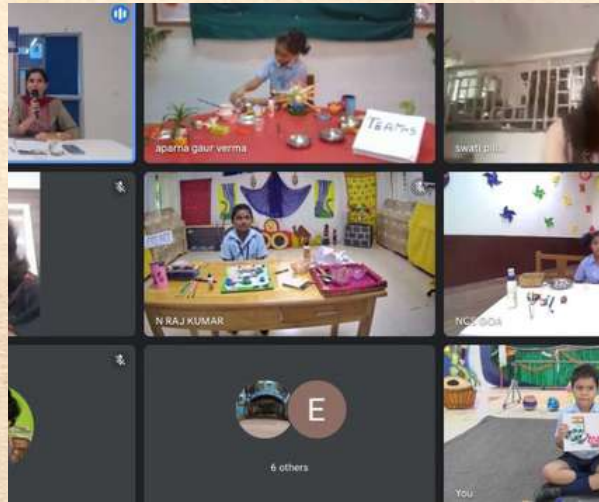

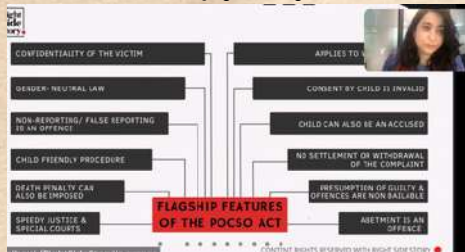
Workshop on Identification of CWSN

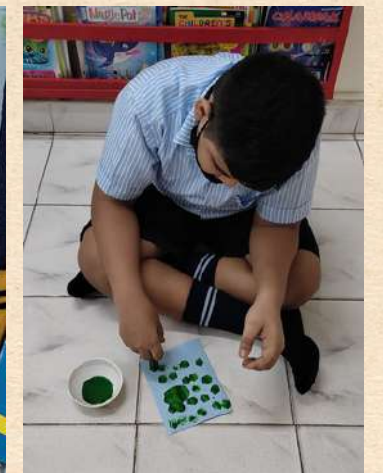

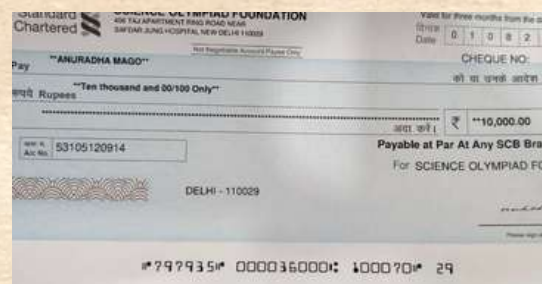

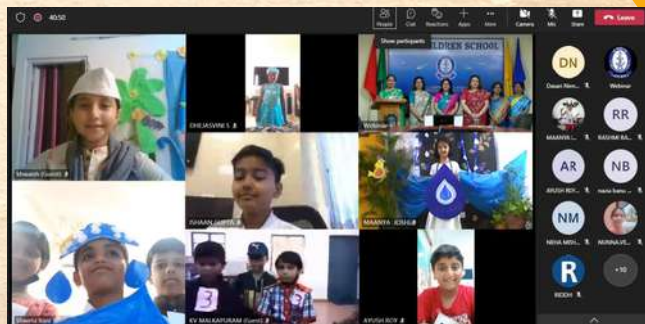
