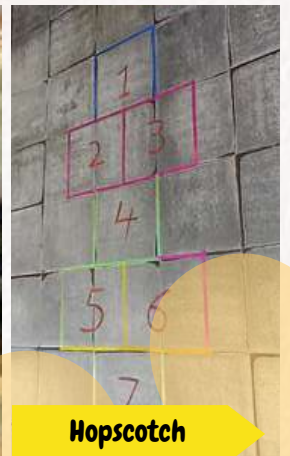




Root Connect

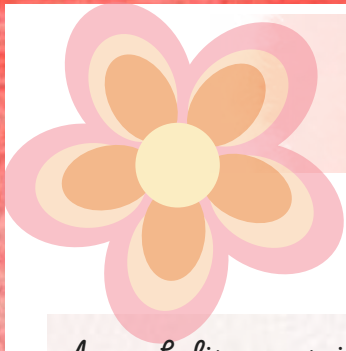


Learning Center
